CENTRALLY AIR CONDITIONED & Wi-Fi CAMPUS

Library

The library has sizeable number of text and reference books. It also subscribes to reputed national and international journals. It has developed electronic teaching materials and databases in form of CDs, audio cassettes and video cassettes.



Computer Lab

GRBS provides state-of-the-art Computer Lab for computing needs of the students. The lab is equipped with powerful servers and latest software packages. Computer lab is fully air conditioned with 30 plus personal computers, networked on LAN with 24 hours internet connectivity of 2 mbps support by a variety of system software.

GRBS campus is fully Wi-Fi connected and a laptop is provided to each student to facilitate continuous learning.



Language Lab

GRBS has an English Language Lab which enables students to improve their accent and vocabulary. The lab provides the use of Lotus linguaphone machines which enables students to listen, record and correct their pronunciation. It is a self-study mechanism and is unique to our B-school.



Learning Hall

Well structured learning hall facilities are designed and equipped with the modern teaching facilities like laptop with internet, LCDs, OHP Slide, well ventilated and accommodated with the nice roomy sitting arrangements to facilitate proper teacher-student interaction.

Auditorium

A multipurpose air-conditioned auditorium with 165 seats capacity is available for seminars, conferences and cultural activities.



Recreational Facilities

Recreational facilities include a huge playground for volleyball and cricket, indoor games like chess and carrom. Entertainment facilities include TV, books and magazines. Common room is also provided for discussions and group work to students.

Hostel Facility

GRBS provides accommodation for students. There are separate hostel for boys and girls. The hostel is fully furnished and is located within the campus to enable students to avail various facilities. The hostel rooms are spacious and comfortable. Each room is provided with Wi-Fi connection.

The hostel also has an adjoining vegetarian mess for 100 students. The canteen is modern and hygienic.

SECOND YEAR

During the second year, in addition to a few compulsory courses, students have to choose optional courses in elective areas. EVALUATION PROCESS

The evaluation pattern is 60-40. Internal evaluation is done for 60 marks and the semester end examination is for 100 marks, scaled down to 40.

Internal evaluation is done on a continuous basis during the semester. At the end of the semester, a written examination is conducted.

A candidate has to secure a minimum of 50 % marks (Internal + External) to pass the course. A candidate securing less than 50% marks in a course shall be deemed to have failed in that course. A student cannot repeat the end semester examination in a course in which he / she has passed to improve the score. A student with arrears can repeat end-semester examination for a maximum of three times (excluding the first appearance) along with the subsequent end-semester examination. The marks obtained in continual evaluation by the student will be carried over for declaring the result.

ADMISSION PROCESS

Eligibility

To be eligible for admission to the PGDM Programme, a candidate must have passed the degree examination of a University or a qualification recognized as equivalent to the degree by AICTE / UGC / Association of Indian Universities. In order to secure admission to the PGDM Programme, the candidate must have preferably secured 50% marks in the bachelor's degree examination.

Candidate who has appeared for the final examination of the degree course can also apply. Their admission will be confirmed only on the proof of satisfactory completion of the degree course.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Selection of candidate will be a two-stage process:

- The first stage will be a national level entrance examination (CAT/ MAT/ XAT/ ATMA) or according to the norms of AICTE.
- The second stage will be a group discussion and personal interview.

Intake Capacity: 60

How to Apply

Obtain GRBS Application Form, from the Institute on payment of Rs. 950/- in cash or DD in favour of 'GIDC ROFEL Business School' payable at Vapi. Alternatively, the application form may be downloaded from the institute's website and submitted to the institute along with a DD of Rs. 950/-. The GRBS application form is required to be submitted to the Institute before appearing for GD/PI.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Institute reserves the right to accept or reject any application or to cancel admission without assigning any reason.
- Canvassing in any form will disqualify the candidate from admission.
- Please note that good physical and mental stamina are pre-requisite for admission to the programme. The students may be asked to produce the medical fitness certificate, if necessary.
- Jurisdiction for any legal dispute will be Vapi only.

The College is located in Vapi which has many strategic advantages due to its proximity to industrial centers and Mumbai - the business capital of India. Vapi's strategic location has been a source of strength - on the Mumbai - Ahmedabad Highway, very close to the sea resorts of Daman and the hilly forest reserves of Silvassa. It also enjoys proximity to the trading centers of Surat and Baroda. Vapi has good schools, hospitals, banks, and commercial complexes.

The development of the Vapi Industrial Estate was started by GIDC in 1967, and has Spread over 11.4 km². It is home to over 1500 industries. The region has also several large-scale units including Reliance Industries, Hindustan Lever, Sterlite Industries, Wel Spun Textiles, Alok Industries, Micro Inks, United Phosphorus Limited, Themis Medicare, Richter Them, is to name a few.

Vapi is easily accessible by road 180 kms from Mumbai and 125 kms from Surat on NH # 8, both of which are well connected by road, rail and air from all major cities in India.

By AIR

The nearest airport is about 200 kms away at Mumbai.

The drive from Mumbai airport to Vapi takes approximately 2.5 hours.

Prepaid taxis are available at the airport.

By RAIL

Vapi railway station is on Mumbai-Ahmedabad Railways line.

Most of the trains between Mumbai to Ahmedabad stop at Vapi.

By ROAD

Vapi is just on the National Highway (NH # 8), connecting Mumbai and Ahmedabad.

Regular, efficient bus services operate between Mumbai, Surat and Ahmedabad.
